### How to Apply

- To start an application, log in to the [GENYOUth School Wellness Portal](#) and click on the welcome message in the top right to access your My Grant Applications page.
- Click on the opportunity and confirm your school at the bottom of the overview page, or search for a different school using the drop-down list.
- Click the Continue button to go to the application.
- Complete all 3 tabs of the application (\* denotes a required question) and submit by midnight EDT on August 19, 2026.
- To be sure your data are saving, be sure to click the Save button at the bottom of each page.
- If desired, you can close the window after saving and return to the Portal later to complete your application.

### Terms and Conditions

- To be eligible to receive grant funding, your school must:
  - be located in the state of California, and
  - participate in the National School Lunch Program; additional consideration will be given to schools that also participate in the National School Breakfast Program.
- Schools will be evaluated to receive equipment grants based on a variety of factors, including the strength of the program, enrollment, and Free and Reduced rate.
- Grantees are expected to implement the service model and equipment no later than January 31, 2026.
- All applications submitted by midnight EDT on August 19, 2026, will be reviewed, and approvals/notifications will be made in September 2026.
- Awards are expected to be delivered in fall 2026. Once delivered, the district/school will assume ownership of the equipment and is responsible for all maintenance and future disposal, as needed.

#### Guidelines and Terms

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- Schools will be evaluated to receive equipment grants based on a variety of factors, including the strength of the program, enrollment, and Free and Reduced rate.
- All applications submitted by midnight EDT on August 19, 2026, will be reviewed, and approvals/notifications will be made in September 2026.
- Awards are expected to be delivered in fall 2026. Once delivered, the district/school will assume ownership of the equipment and is responsible for all maintenance and future disposal, as needed.
- Grantees are expected to implement the service model and equipment no later than January 31, 2026.
- If the application is approved, your district must comply with all reporting requirements, where you will be asked to document the use and impact of the funding (See the Reporting section below).
- Limit one award per school, not to exceed \$5,000.
- Schools are eligible to apply even if they have received other funding to support health, physical activity and wellness.

## Reporting

- Awarded schools will be required to provide feedback on the equipment's use via an online survey next spring.
- The survey will ask for data points including, but not limited to:
  - Total Number of Serving Days
  - Average Daily Participation (ADP) for Breakfast and Lunch
- Failure to comply with the required reporting may prohibit your school from receiving future funding.

## Other Terms

- Equipment awarded is the property of the school that is approved and may not be transferred to another school, institution or individual without prior written approval of the funder.
- Schools receiving equipment agree to provide information about use of the equipment, if requested by GENYOUth.
- All information provided to GENYOUth in connection with the Super Schools 61 Application, including all related communications, is true, correct and complete.
- Approved recipient will maintain complete and accurate records for the program and will make such records available to GENYOUth upon request.
- Approved recipient agrees to share success, if requested, to demonstrate progress made toward strengthening meal participation and operational readiness.
